Objectives

An effective poster presentation requires a cleverly designed poster, an appropriate use of language and the ability to present it in a dialogue. This course will give you the skills you need to create professional, attractive and high-impact posters and give you the opportunity to practice the communication skills needed to make your research interesting and accessible for your audience.

Topics

- Preparation
 - Perform a context analysis (who, when, where, why, what)
 - Craft the 'story' of your poster
- Conference Setting
 - Poster as chore or opportunity?
 - Poster as catalyst for networking
- Poster design
 - Structure and layout
 - Best-/worst-practice samples
 - Optimise the impact of illustrations and graphs
 - Graphical abstract
- Poster pitch
 - Presenting yourself, your research and the poster itself
 - Learn to interact with the audience (leading with questions, answering questions, discussion)

Methods

We will have 4 live-webinars of +/- 2 hours. Between the webinars you will spend time on the online learning platform of NaturalScience.Careers. After the seminar you will have an additional 3 weeks access to the platform.

Schedule

Four online live-webinar sessions between 09.00 - 11.00 and 14.00 - 16.00 hrs spread over 2 days. Between the live-webinars, you will spend time on the online learning platform provided.

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Format

The course will be given online via Zoom. Participants need a laptop or desktop computer incl. video conferencing tools (webcam, speaker/headphone) and a good internet connection. Access to the online learning platform will be given before the start of the course. **Participants are expected to turn on their cameras for the full duration of the course.** Please sign up only, if you agree to show yourself to the others.
