Objectives

In the past months, online formats have become increasingly important. Many conferences project meetings, thesis defences and job interviews have been and will be held in virtual environments. Scientists need to be able to present themselves and their research in online pitches, virtual presentations and videos.

In this interactive workshop, we will share experiences, have a look at best practice examples and prepare our own presentations/videos while receiving feedback from the other participants.

Topics

Day 1 - morning

- Which tools are available for video recording? (open source, local, collection experience from everyone)
- How do I cut and structure a video?
- How do I bring my message across? (pitch talks, difference 3 and 10 min talk)
- Which graphics/visualizations/cliff hanger work for poster presentations and conference talks?

<u>afternoon</u>: prepare a presentation or video for the next day

<u>Day 2</u>

- Presentation of talks and videos + individual feedback
- Open discussion about gained experiences. What went well, what didn't?
- Possible to upload a recorded video to MARUM server and ask for feedback within the next week

Methods

Short impulse presentations, exchange and discussion about best practice models; preparing an own presentation/video, providing and receiving constructive feedback
