Using Ocean Data View (ODV) and webODV (ODV online) for Science Problems

Objectives

This course will demonstrate general concepts and capabilities of the data analysis and visualization software Ocean Data View (ODV, https://odv.awi.de/). The course consists of overview presentations, guided software usage sessions, and hands-on exercise work suitable for beginners as well as more advanced ODV users. In addition, the new online version of ODV, named webODV (https://webodv.awi.de) will be used.

You will learn how to download and import important oceanographic data sets, and will then use these datasets to address scientific questions. A variety of plots will be created, including profiles and time-series curves, as well as gridded and contoured sections and geographic maps. You are invited to bring your own data (in spreadsheet-like formats) and may use these data during the course.

Topics / Programme

Session I:

- General Overview – ODV capabilities, plot types and supported data types

- webODV - The online ODV version

- Guided hands-on operation of the ODV software I (Window elements, left-clicking, right-clicking, station/sample selection, derived variables, saving/loading views, surface-plot (BGC-Argo), section-plot (MOSAiC))

Session II:

Guided hands-on operation of the ODV software II (Station filter, modifying the layout, window scopes, spreadsheet format, creating collections, importing data)

Session III:

Hands-on exercises I: Data import of own data, if provided; *WoceBtl* section plots; presentations by participants

Session IV:

Hands-on exercises II: Distributions on iso-surfaces; estimation at user-provided locations; presentations by participants
